

Sustainable Procurement and Responsible Sourcing Policy

At Momentive, we are committed to fostering sustainable procurement and responsible sourcing practices that align with our vision to bring sustainable solutions to our customers. Our suppliers span the globe, and together with Momentive, play a critical role in delivering sustainable solutions that benefit the planet through the following objectives:

1. Improving the sustainability practices in our supply chain
2. Delivering value to our stakeholders through improvement of sustainable procurement practices and implementation of low carbon solutions.

Scope

This policy applies to externally sourced goods and services and external suppliers within the scope of Momentive's procurement practices.

Framework

This policy outlines our approach to integrating sustainability into procurement processes to deliver actions consistently based on the sustainability principles we prioritize at Momentive.

- We strive to have our suppliers comply with [Momentive's Supplier Code of Conduct](#), which sets out specific requirements related to human rights, labor conditions, anti-corruption, and environmental protection. Momentive seeks to do business with suppliers sharing and supporting the standards set in the Supplier Code of Conduct.
- We source responsibly and consider sustainability aspects when selecting our materials, goods and services suppliers. Based on our value chain risk profile, we prioritize prevention of human rights violations within Momentive's supply chains.
- We reduce the environmental impact of our operations and products across our value chain through social, economic and environmentally sustainable actions and solutions.
- We work with our suppliers to measure and improve their sustainability practices in order to meet our sustainability goals while also delivering value to the business and our customers.

We are a member of the Roundtable for Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) and, as such, endeavor to increase sourcing of sustainable palm oil with deforestation-free criteria, complete with transparency, traceability and focus on biodiversity.

We conduct sustainability assessments and audits of our suppliers (using both third-party and our own standards) to measure performance in management, environmental impact, health and safety, labor and human rights, and governance.

We collaborate on Scope 3 Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions carbon accounting methodologies, including product carbon footprint (PCF).

Targets

Momentive tracks and reports progress against its sustainable procurement targets as part of its broader sustainability reporting and carbon footprint reduction efforts. These targets include:

- Reducing Scope 3 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 25% by 2030
- Achieving a 100% annual training rate for commodity managers on sustainable procurement practices
- Incorporating references to the Supplier Code of Conduct in new contracts with targeted suppliers
- Supplier engagement of greater than 90% of targeted supply base with EcoVadis Rating
- Achieving 100% electricity from renewable sources by 2030.

Oversight and Review

By implementing this policy, Momentive aims to create a positive sustainability impact. It is reviewed and updated at least annually. Our Momentive Procurement Team will execute the provisions of the policy with oversight by our Vice President of Global Procurement.

We are committed to collaborating with our suppliers to achieve our sustainability objectives and continuously improve our procurement practices.

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
