Product Description

Niax Silicone L-537XF is an all-purpose silicone stabilizer that is an excellent candidate for use in polyester foam formulations. Niax Silicone L-537XF generally provides excellent stabilization, fine cell structure and reduces the need for organic surfactants and emulsifiers. Niax Silicone L-537XF does not contain nonylphenol ethoxylates, which have been identified by USEPA as presenting potential environmental concerns.

Key Features and Typical Benefits

- Generally useful for a wide range of polyester slabstock foams
- Has been shown to provide fine cell structure and minimize the density and breathability gradient of the foam
- Typical use level is 0.5 – 1.7 php, depending on the formulation. The correct use level must be defined for each individual polyester formulation
- Clear low-viscosity liquid, easy to meter in separate stream
- Typically stable in water-amine premix(1)
- Paraffin oil can be safely used in polyester die-cuttable foams using Niax Silicone L-537XF
